- Develop a mini version of the evaluation framework to apply to local on-going projects. Particular focus on methods and measures/indicators sought. (Philip Scott, UK)

- Inventory of outcome measures, then of methods to acquire these (Jan Talmon, Jytte Brender).
- Select case studies, linked to 'cook book' to indicate which parts of GEP-HI to select to which type of products.
- Evaluation of mobile apps – usability, screen design, etc..
- *Develop guidance for Vendors on how to conduct trails for the Medical Devices Directive; to lead to Position Paper. Include particular focus on patient usability. (Rainer Röhrig)*
- *Methods and Indicators for evaluation of usability, including documentation; to lead to international standardisation. (Sylvia Pelayo)*
- Identify economics expertise [PT] with UserLab Lille.
